KABUL ATLAS HOSPITAL PROFILE

Kabul Atlas Hospital is a well-known medical facility located in Kabul, Afghanistan. It was established in June 2020 via a group of professional doctors and now It provides a wide range of secondary and tertiary healthcare services to both local residents and expatriates. The hospital is particularly notable for its expert and well trained young doctors in Pakistan and India as well as the modern infrastructure and equipment in a country where healthcare resources can be limited.

Kabul Atlas Hospital has a reputation for offering high-quality medical, surgical, Radiology/diagnostic gyne/obstetrics and emergency services, including all sub and over specialized services such as pediatrics, ICU/NICU trauma/orthopedics, ENT, Urology/UroSurgery, Radiology, diagnostic/lab services, laparoscopic and non-laparoscopic surgeries, gyne/obs, Psychiatry, gastroenterology, cardiology, infectious disease, plastic/cosmetic surgery, dermatology, dental/maxio-facial surgeries, neurology and neuro-surgery,

Kabul Atlas is a private hospital which operates by the personal expenses of the patients, therefore Kabul Atlas is striving to seek some international partners to ensure a high standard of treatment with full or half subsidy to the war and drought stricken communities and of deep rural and remote provinces of the Afghanistan as we as for the urban people because of the high number of people being jobless due to the recent change of regime and previous bad security of the last few years.

The hospital is well equipped with advanced foreign imported diagnostic, surgical and invasive tools and is staffed by a mix of Afghan doctors and foreign healthcare professionals.it provides job facility to **170 Afghan** and **10s** foreign individual as well as **150 suppliers** in such a situation where people so much need the job and family support. Kabul Atlas generally support and benefit the urban, remote, rural and deep rural patient with a very high and special **discount of almost 20%** in the laboratory, In patient services and procedures.

Kabul Atlas has had a very generous donation to its customer of **17,348,282Afghanis** equal to **195,245\$(4%)** of the total revenue). It's worth mentioning that Kabul Atlas has contracted the current government (Islamic Emirates of Afghanistan) for the treatment of Mujahedeen and its official patient with more than **30% off** in the lab, IPD, procedures.

Kabul Atlas as an independent entity is respecting all the rule/regulation of the government and proud to support the government with paying all the logo taxes where Kabul Atlas paid 21,000,000 Afghanis (**229,169\$ tax**) in the last 4 years and is committed to further support and respect the rules.

This hospital has been a significant medical/surgical provider in Kabul, especially for those seeking care beyond what is available in government-run hospitals. However, like many institutions in Afghanistan, it has faced challenges related to security, political instability, improper treatment of the taxation and legislative departments and occasional attacks on healthcare facilities.

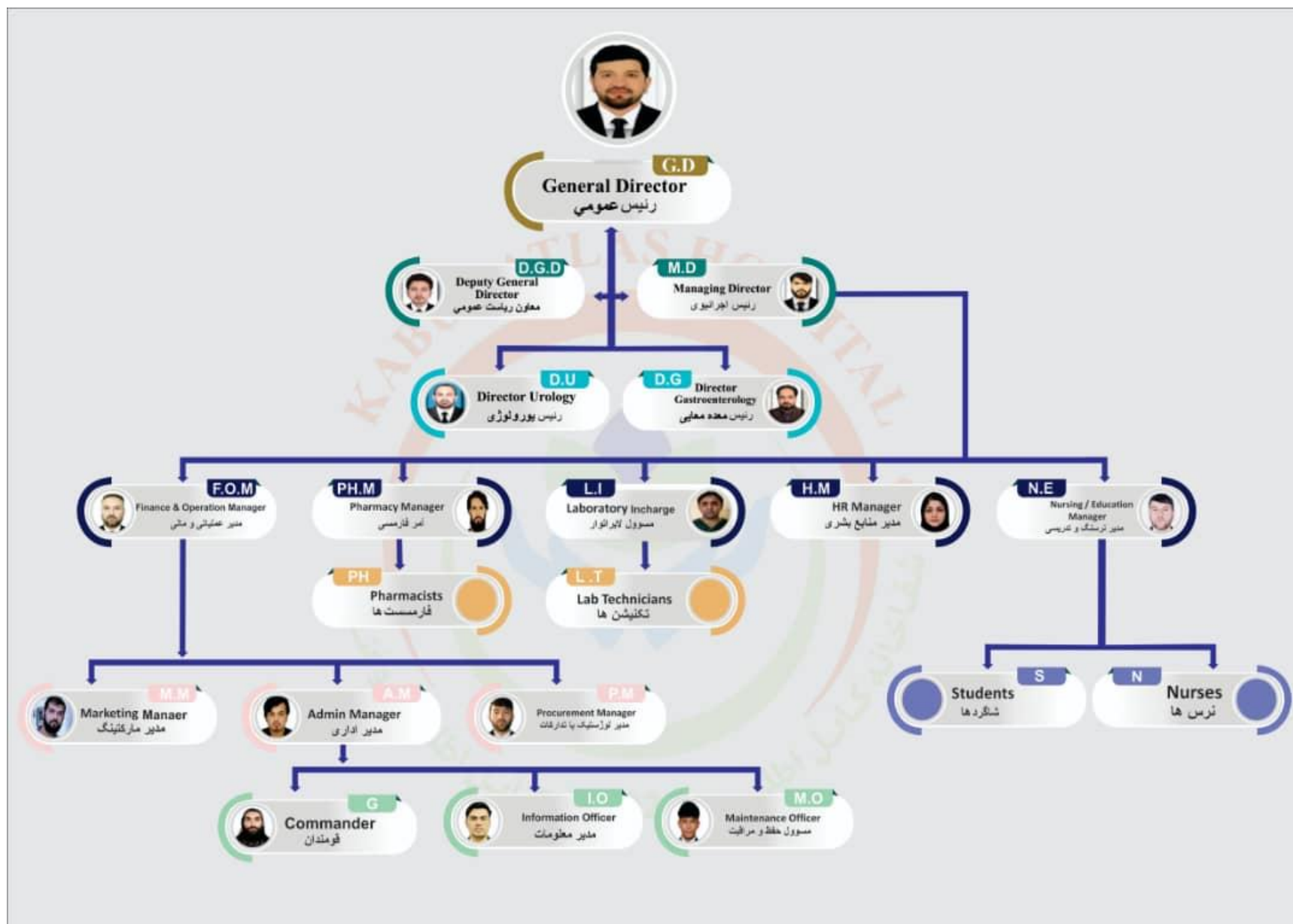

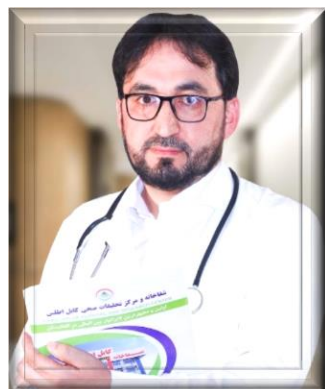

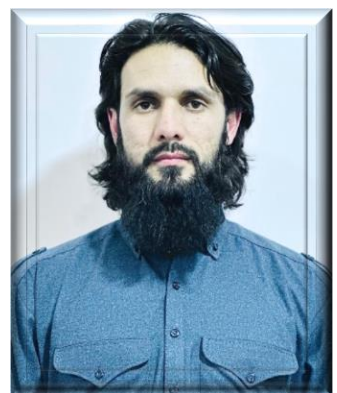
Currently serving as Media Manager in Kabul atlas hospital

23. Maintenance Officer

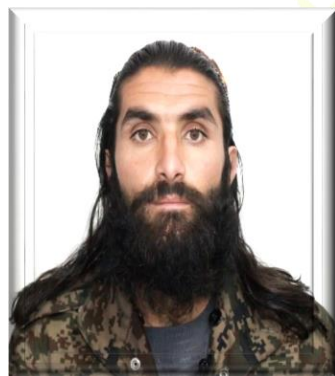
